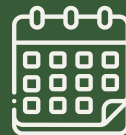

Carbon Farm Forestry Tool

The Tasmanian Forestry Hub has partnered with local tech company Indicium Dynamics to develop a carbon estimation tool for landowners to calculate the carbon sequestered on their property.

In a world first, farmers will be able to quickly estimate how many trees are required to offset livestock emissions with the easy to navigate Carbon Farm Forestry Tool, which the Hub hopes will encourage landowners to plant more trees on their properties.

A team will also be engaged over the three-day event to consult with 200 farmers, encouraging them to perform a short, three-minute confidential estimation using the technology on mobile devices.

All data is Tasmania-specific and will be instrumental in helping Tasmanian agriculture—and Tasmania more broadly—maintain its global leading emissions record.

Workforce Development Portal

The Workforce and Diversity Portal has been developed as part of the Forest Industry Workforce Development and Diversity Project, funded by the Tasmanian Government, and will provide and collate information on workforce development, diversity, inclusion, and training relevant to employers, employees and the community on the Tasmanian forest industry.

Employers in the forest industry will be able to easily access information on employment, training, apprenticeships and more, while employees learn more about training and planning their careers.

This centralised portal means people outside the forest industry and the community can learn about how to enter the forest industry, what training is required, what the career pathways are and information about the Tasmanian Forest Industry and its contribution to the Tasmanian economy.
